Parking

To ensure the safety and peace of mind of all residents, parking of vehicles is prohibited in the vicinity of homes.

A designated parking space is available for your vehicle at the entrance of the estate.



Non-smoking lodging

An ashtray is provided for smoking exclusively on the terrace.

Please refrain from disposing of your cigarette butts in natural environments. FIRE RISK!

Waste and refuse segregation

The garbage containers (yellow and green) are situated in the town hall square, where glass collection is also available.



Toilet

The cottage utilizes a septic tank; we would like to emphasize this aspect.

Only toilet paper should be disposed of in the toilet; wipes, sanitary towels, tampons, and other waste must be placed in the trash.

Avoid using bleach in the cottage.

Alternatively, if you prefer to clean on your own, please follow this procedure:

Before your departure, we kindly request that you dust, clean the floors (using a vacuum cleaner and mop), sanitize the bathroom (including the shower, sink, and siphons), and attend to the toilets. In the kitchen area, please ensure that everything is cleaned (including household appliances such as the oven, microwave, refrigerator, and sink) and that the dishes are put away.

Empty and sanitize all trash receptacles in the accommodation.

Prior to your departure

Domain Regulations



To ensure their safety, do not allow your children to roam the property or the pool area without supervision.

AT THE SWIMMING POOL:



- Swimming pool dimensions: 8.5 x 4.2 m depth: 1.5 m
- The swimming pool is outfitted with two safety devices (NF P90-307-1).
- This is a family pool, unsupervised and designated for private use, accessible to the owners and tenants of the cottage, with each individual assuming responsibility. Please refer to the internal regulations that you have signed.

An adult's presence is required when children are in the swimming pool.

FOREST STROLLS:



- Observe the signs.
- Let us adhere to access restrictions during high-risk periods, such as storms and strong winds.
- Remove your waste
- Fires, including cigarettes, barbecues, and other open flames, are strictly prohibited.
- Ban traverses unmarked paths.
- Do not collect dead wood, as it serves as a refuge for fungi, insects, and birds, and also contributes to soil fertility.
- Honor wildlife



• Children are the exclusive responsibility of their accompanying adults (parents or guardians).

AT THE LAKE:



- Swimming is explicitly forbidden.
- Recreational fishing is permitted solely from the shores of the lake associated with the Bois de Cassanhac estate.
- Fires, including cigarettes, barbecues, and other open flames, are strictly prohibited.
- Children are the exclusive responsibility of their guardians (parents or accompanying adults) and must never be left without supervision.
